BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Contact the SENPOS support team on (02) 4940 0620 to make sure they are available for the installation, as they may be required.

Preparing the Terminal

 Make sure the terminal is in Integrated mode. If it's already there, skip to #2. Menu → Terminal Settings → Operating mode → Integrated.



2. Menu \rightarrow Manage POS Pairing \rightarrow Blue + Don't push start yet - leave the terminal on this screen for now.

- b. Serial (displayed on the previous terminal screen)
- c. IP Address (you will need to uncheck Auto-Address in order to enter this in IP is on the terminal screen)
- d. Payment Provider (Next Payments)
