



SwiftPOS Integration Procedure

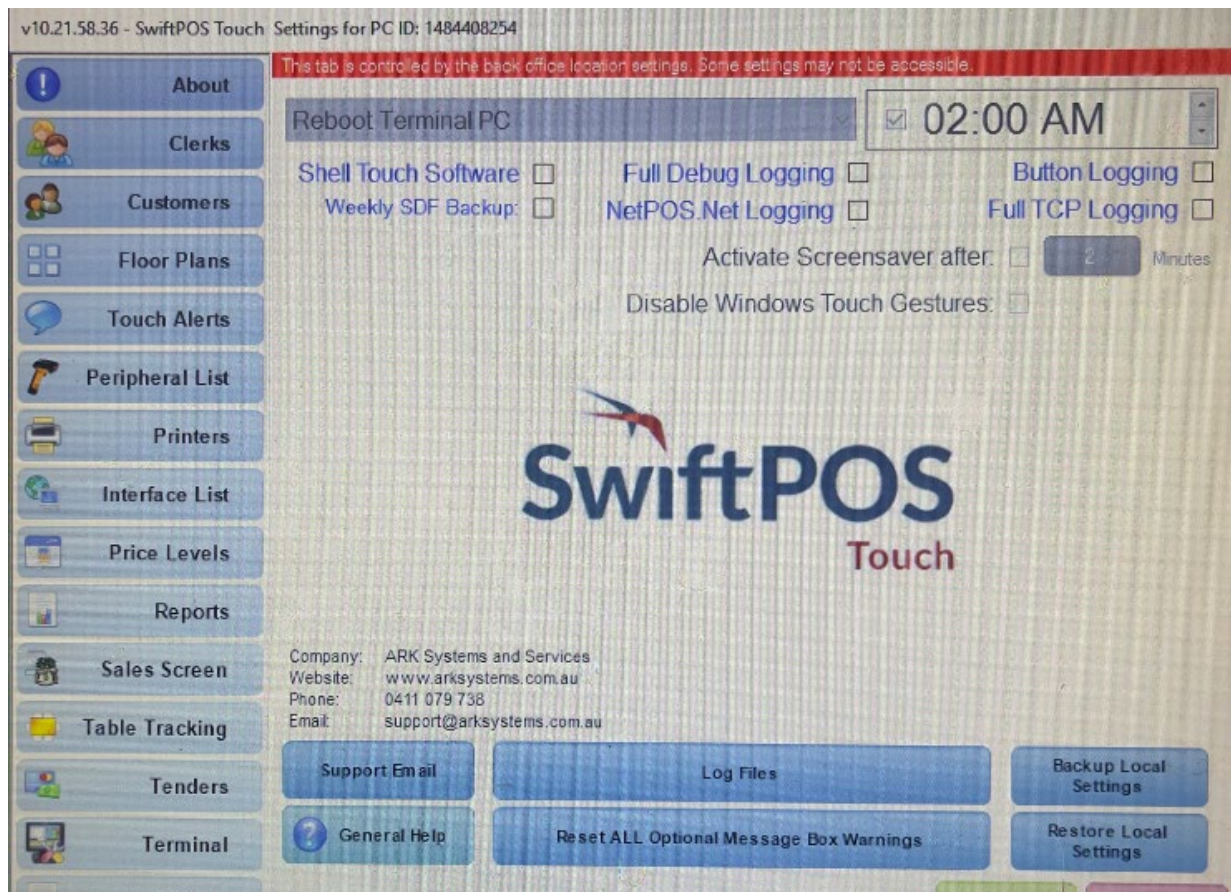


BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Contact the SwiftPOS reseller to make sure they are available for the installation, as they will need to perform some back office configuration to finish the integration.

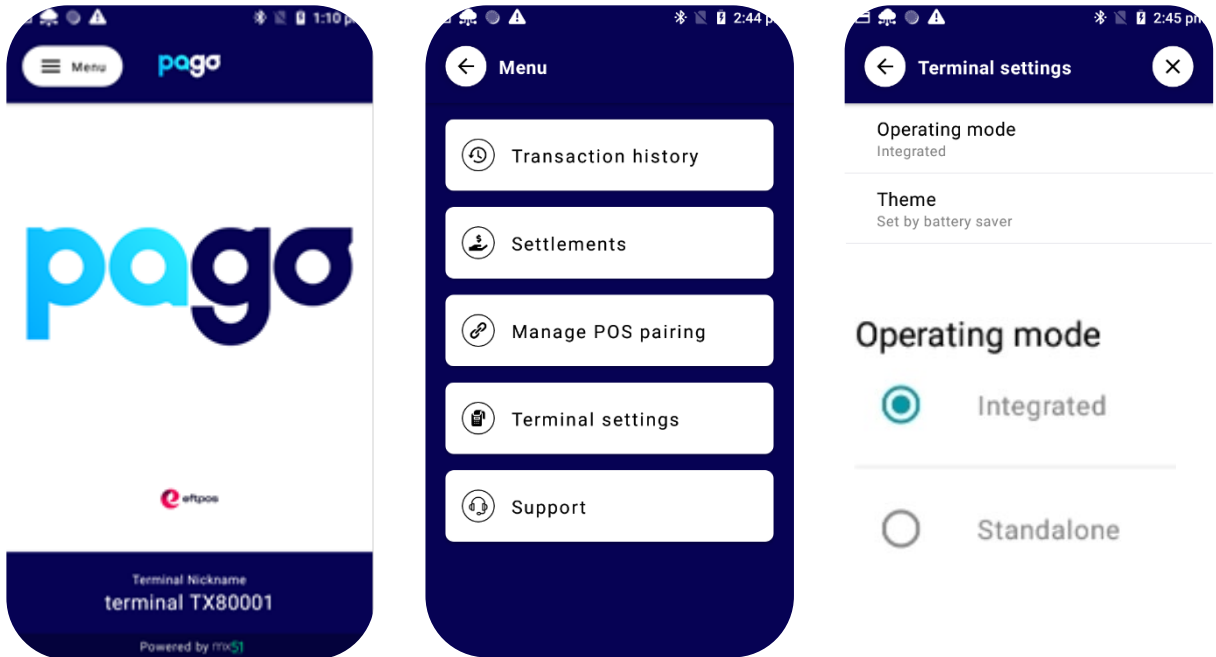
Finding the Reseller contact information

Within SwiftPOS touch, ask the merchant to go to Tools → About
The reseller information should be displayed on this page

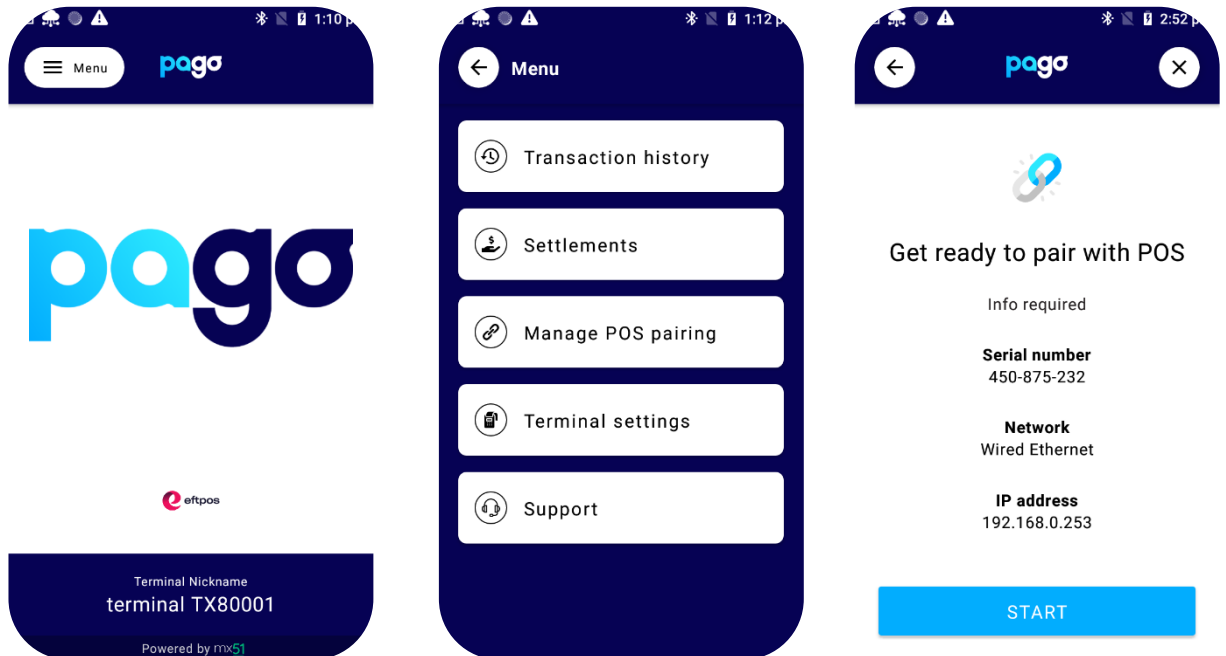


Preparing the Terminal

1. Make sure the terminal is in Integrated mode. If it's already there, skip to #2. Menu → Terminal Settings → Operating mode → Integrated.



2. Menu → Manage POS Pairing → Blue + Don't push start yet - leave the terminal on this screen for now.



Pairing the Terminal with Spice

This process is in two parts.

1. Download and install the latest Spice from here: <https://spice.integration.mspenv.io/latest.exe>
2. Run the installer, and accept the EULA
3. Select **Next Payments** from the list of Payment providers
4. Enter the POS ID (This is usually the same as how the POS is identified. (E.g POS1, Lounge bar, Restaurant, Reception)
5. Enter the IP Address of the terminal from the screenshot above

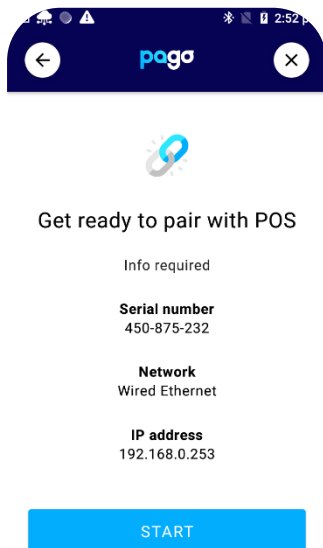

6. Select **Start** on the Terminal, then Pair on **Spice**
7. Make sure the codes match, select **Yes** on the terminal. Then Finish

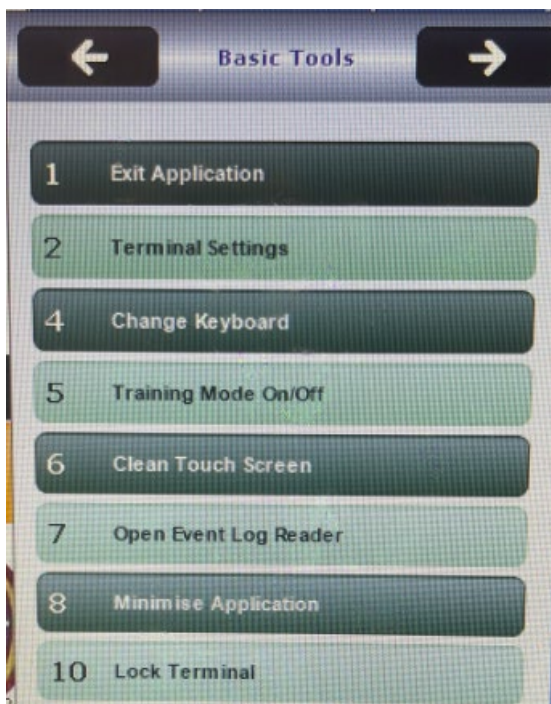

Enabling SwiftPOS to use PAGO

1. Open the SwiftPOS Touch application
2. Click on the **Tools** menu



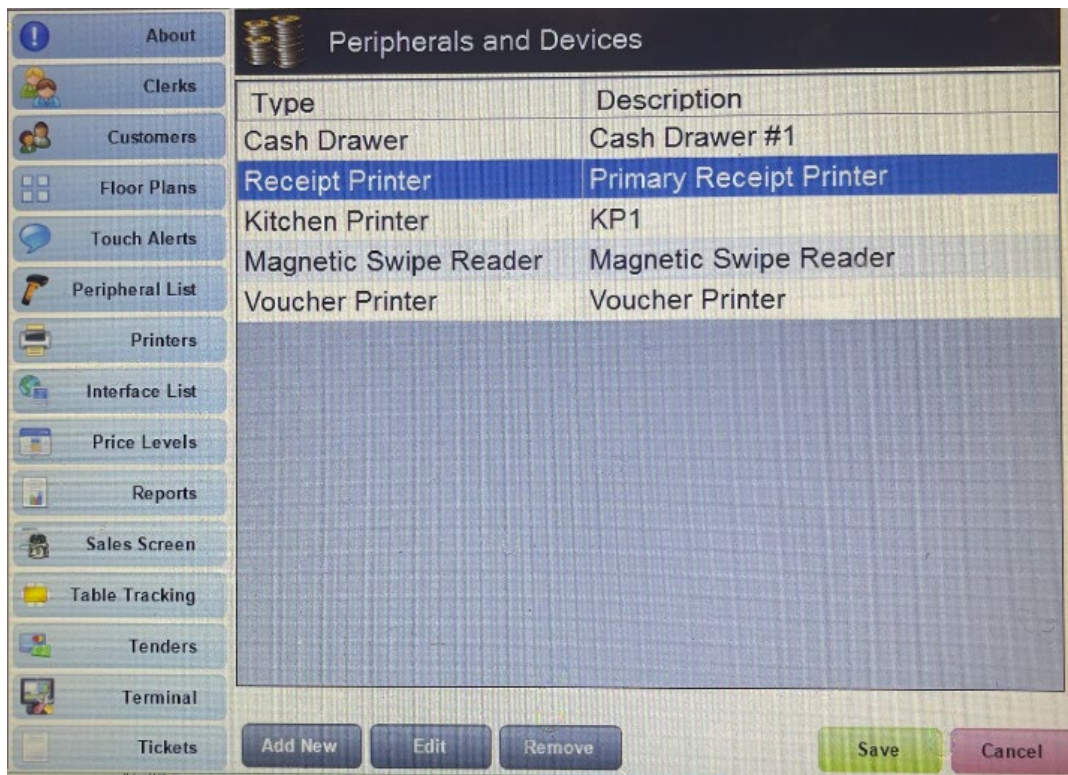
3. Select **Terminal Settings**



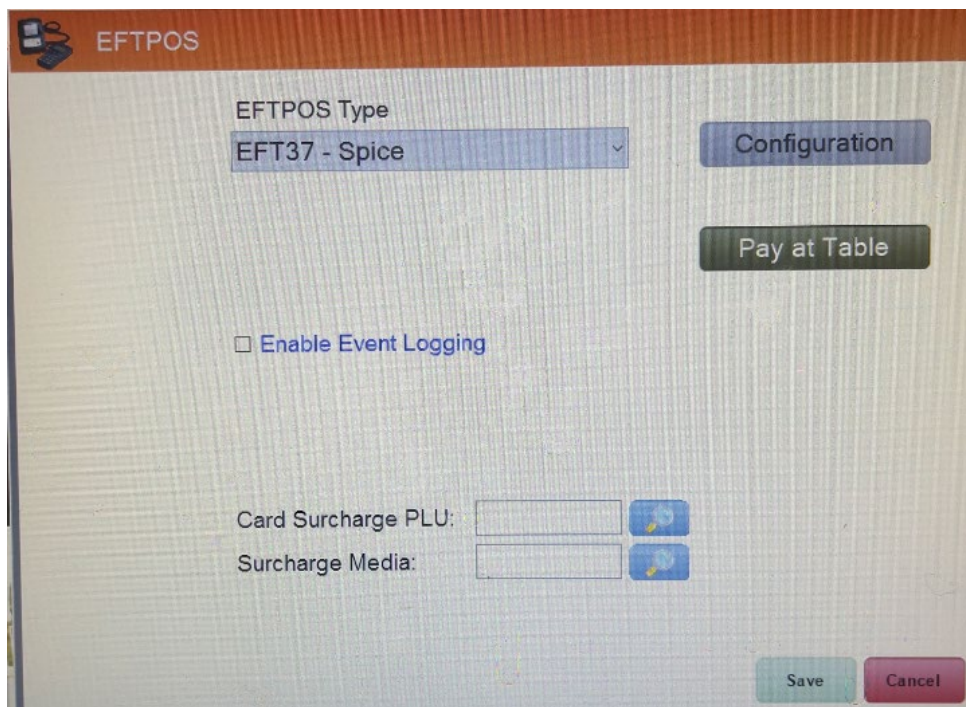
4. Select Peripheral List



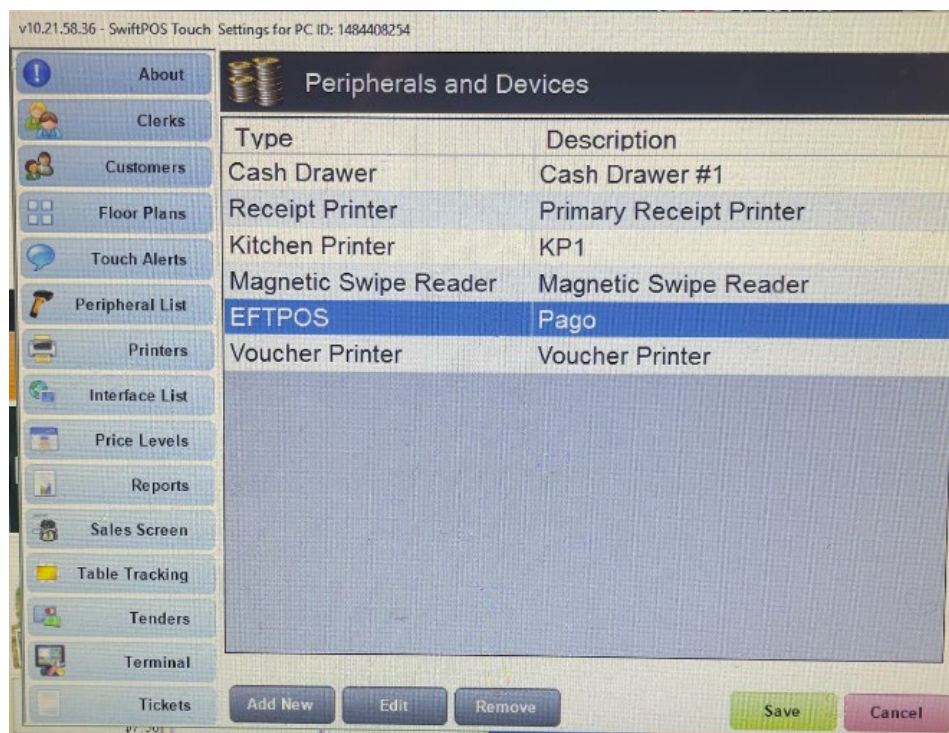
5. Select Add New



6. Select EFT37 – Spice



7. Give it a suitable name.



There is nothing more to configure here. The next steps are to contact the reseller to complete the integration. Ask the reseller to configure the Eftpos button on the keypad to point to the above Payment type you created.
